

This letter serves as authenticity for the following football helmet:

Scott McClintock 2005 Game Worn University of Michigan Wolverines

This painted maize and blue “winged” helmet worn by linebacker, Scott McClintock, is a Riddell model VSR-4, size L (7 -7 1/2). Near the inside of the left ear hole is the number “36” written in black marker. Inside is a re-certification sticker from All American. Other identifying stickers include a #36 player number and manufacturer's warning label on back right. There are Riddell manufacture stickers on each side of the inside of the shell. The original chin strap has a blue Nike neoprene cover. Attached is the original Schutt face mask, with the date code of DJC.

The helmet shows good game use including a scrape in the maize paint on the right “wing”, blue marks on the right front and right back. Photos of the helmet are shown below, including a photo of McClintock wearing this helmet during the Northern Illinois University vs. the University of Michigan game in 2005.

This helmet was issued to McClintock after the sixth game of the 2003 season and was worn through the 2005 football season. His original helmet was cracked during a collision with Iowa's Abdul Hodge on a kickoff. The original helmet is still in McClintock's possession.

During his career, McClintock tallied 143 tackles (90 solo, 53 assisted), 8 tackles for a loss, two fumble recoveries, and three interceptions.

I confirm that the subject helmet was worn by me during my final two and-a-half seasons at the University of Michigan.

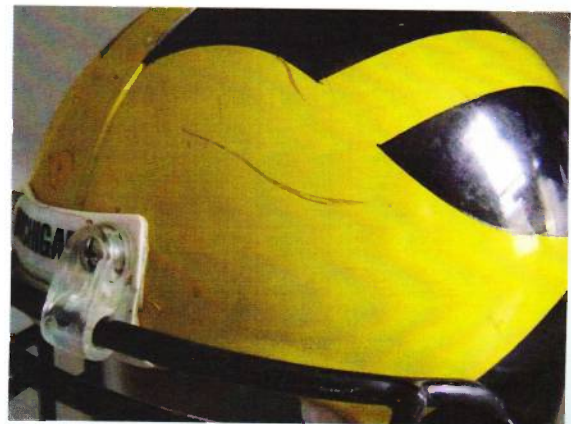

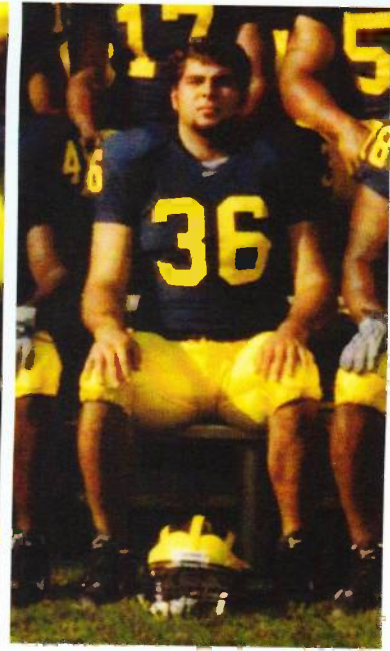

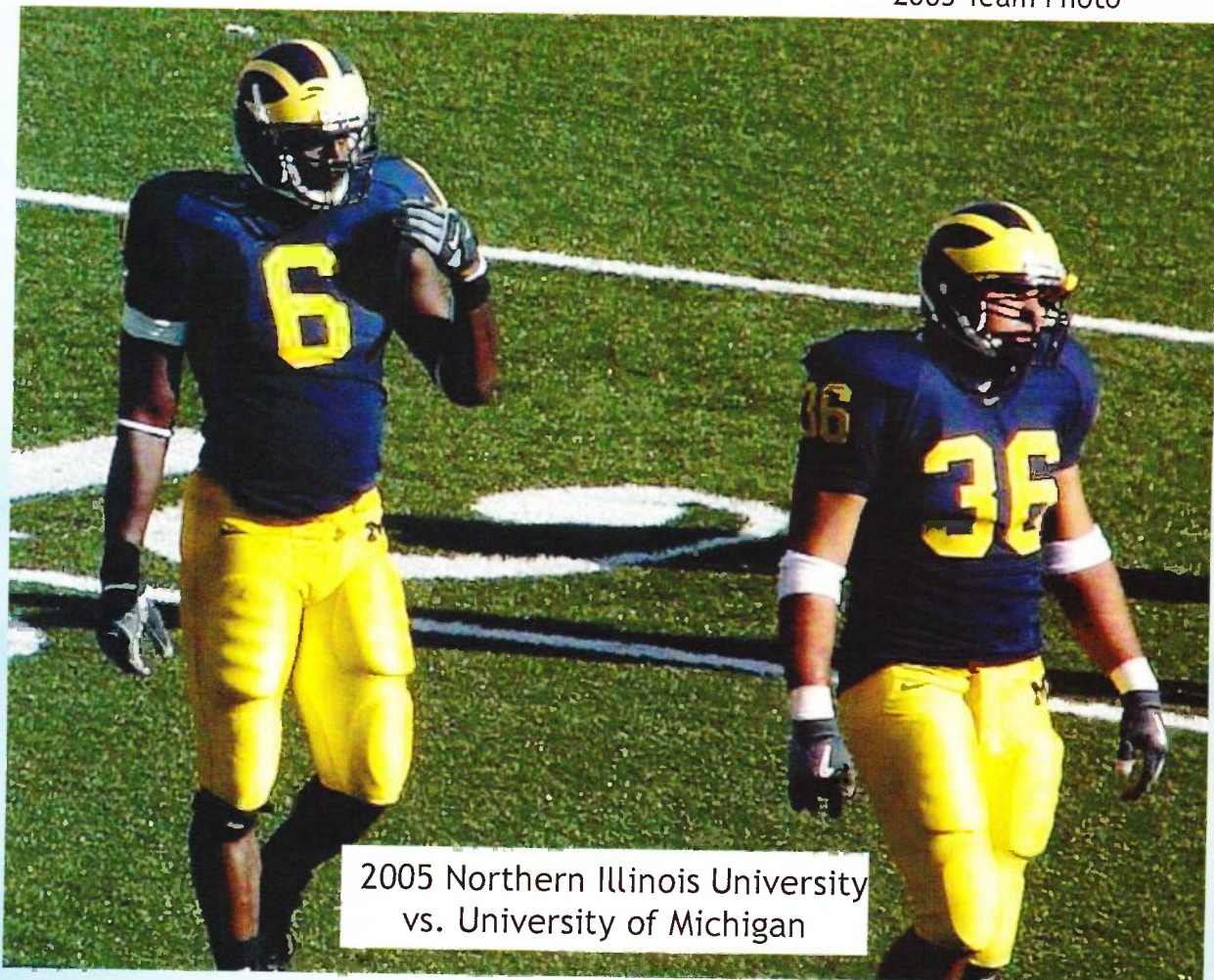
